Le Villain Family:

Michel Le Villain, middle class merchant (1601), counselor and alderman of the town hall of Rouen (1608), president of the bourgeois and alderman (1630), married Marguerite Trabouillard, daughter of Pierre Trabouillard and Madeleine de la Hogue. They had:

1. Marie Le Villain, married (contract 20 June 1601, recognized 30 July)
Henry Le Barbier

2. Madeleine Le Villain
3. Michel Le Villain

The Le Febvre Family:

Henry Lefebvre dit L'Aine, royal sergeant and salesman at Rouen, living in the parish of St. Maclou; He had of Madeleine Duchesne at least three children:

1. Henry Lefebvre II
2. Marthe Lefebvre, married first to Martin Le Barbier (see above) in 1574; married a second time to Jonas de Maistre.
3. N...., wife of Charles Bellin.
